



CIVIL RIGHTS TRAINING

Texas Department of Agriculture

Effective May 15, 2022, the annual Civil Rights training that meets USDA requirements as mandated in FNS Instruction 113-1 will be provided through the Institute of Child Nutrition (ICN) rather than TDA.

New users must register with ICN, and ICN will issue completion certificates. Starting May 15, links to the online training and instructions for taking ICN classes can be found here.
